Dear Mr Kirk

RE: Application to vary Restraining Order – Witness Summons

I am in receipt of your letter, dated 2nd January 2013.I note from your correspondence that you are seeking a witness summons for Dr. and Dr. G Jones.

Before the court can grant a witness summons, the court must be satisfied of two matters:

- 1) that the person who is to be summonsed is able to give material evidence; and
- 2) that it is in the interests of justice to issue a summons to secure the attendance of that person to give evidence.

It is not clear from your correspondence the evidence that the persons are able to give or why it is on the interests of justice for the court to issue a witness summons. You will need to provide this information, together with the full names and addresses of the witnesses, before the court can consider your request further.

For your assistance, I enclose a blank copy of a template that is used when persons wish to apply for a witness summons.
