Solicitors Windsor Place Cardiff. I have worked there
for the last eighteen months. I am responsible of the
financial management and management of all support staff.

I am not involved in any of the care work undertaken
by any of the solicitors employed by the practice.

My line manager is Mr Adrian OLIVER who is
a Senior Partner. I am aware through general conversation
that he often has a conflict of interest in a case he
is involved in with a Mr Martin KIRK. I am not aware of the full
extent of this case and I have never met Mr Kirk.

I am aware that previously Mr Kirk has attended at
the office and caused a nuisance but this was prior to
me joining the firm and have never witnessed any similar incidents
since. At approximately 2pm - 2.30pm on Friday 19 June 2004 I was at my desk in my
office when a telephone call was received at reception. The
receptionist informed me that it was from a Mr Kirk who wanted to
speak to Mr OLIVER. I decided to take the call and it was diverted to

"What does your practice normally do to exchange statements or documents?"
 There had been no introduction from the male and on asking who was speaking he replied "MARGARET KIRK".

I explained to Mr Kirk that on a practice we normally exchange such item by post but this varies from solicitor to solicitor and from case to case.

Mr Kirk further explained that he had received a E-Mail from Mr OLIVER regarding the exchange of documents. I am not aware of the content of that e-mail but suggested to Mr Kirk that he reply to Mr OLIVER via e-mail to make arrangement for the exchange of documents.

- It was obvious to me that Mr Kirk was not satisfied by my answer and made a comment that I should get myself briefed on the subject. I recall that whilst beginning to answer his comment I stopped mid sentence and Mr Kirk made a further comment noting that he could tell that I was running out of words, and suggested that I go and speak to Adrian and telephone him back.

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I have been given the victim personal statement (VPS) leaflet and the VPS scheme has been explained to me. What follows is what I wish to say in connection with this matter. I understand that what I say may be used in various ways and that it may be disclosed to the defence.

Q1446. I did with the full telephone number down but I do not recall if I have retelled this. Mr KIRK has ended the call. This telephone call lasted no more than two minutes. Initially Mr Kirk was inquisitive in his manner but as the conversation progressed he became more agitated.

At the conclusion of the conversation with Mr KIRK I spoke to Mr OLIVER who stated that he would communicate with me via E-mail. I did not return Mr Kirk's telephone call.

At 3.40 p.m. that same day I received a second telephone call from Mr KIRK. Again there was no preamble and the conversation began with an 'apology' to Mr KIRK here I suggest that I take a breath, tie it to my document and throw it through your window; maybe that's how I should give you my documents.

I replied to Mr KIRK by telling him that I strongly advised him not to do that and to get in touch with Adrian.

Mr KIRK did not reply to this and I put the phone down.

This conversation lasted approximately 20/30 seconds.

At the time of this conversation I recall being concerned that Mr KIRK

After this call there were a further two calls which I declined to answer. I know these were from Mr. Hinch because his telephone number appeared on the caller identification display on my telephone.

At approximately 4pm I left my desk to attend a meeting elsewhere and on my return at 5pm I noticed that the visual mail light on my phone had been activated indicating that a message had been left on the phone. I immediately answered it and found that it was from Mr. Hinch. The message was that Mr. Hinch was prepared to exchange documents at the Civil Justice Court Cardiff at 10am on Monday; and if we wanted to do it any earlier, to let him know.

I have saved the recording on the telephone.

I have not replied to Mr. Hinch and have not had any further communication from him.

An previously stated I have never met Mr. Hinch but would describe him as being educated with no hint of Welsh in it.


